• If you are sending artwork for **color copies**, please be sure to convert any spot colors to **CMYK**. **ALL ARTWORK SUBMITTED TO ARROW VISUAL DESIGN MUST BE IN EITHER CMYK FOR FULL COLOR WORK, OR SEPARATED INTO APPROPRIATE SPOT COLORS. NO RGB FILES WILL BE ACCEPTED**.

VEHICLE WRAPS:

Vehicle templates are available from Arrow Visual Design. You may use them as a guide when designing artwork for vehicle wraps and to create a mockup of the finished product (see Figure 1.0), *however these files are not suitable for printing*. Once the design has been finalized, the art must be adjusted to facilitate proper printing and installation.

For example, Figure 1.0 to the right was created as a mockup, to show the client how the final wrapped vehicle will appear.

In order to print this artwork and install it properly, the file must be adjusted prior to submission to Arrow Visual Design. In the final file for the passenger side of this vehicle (Figure 2.0), the vehicle shape from the template has been removed, and the imagery has been extended to allow for the necessary 5" bleed. (Remember that as indicated on page 1 of this document the file should be created at 25% scale, 500dpi, so in the file the bleed will only be 1.25 inches.)

You **must** include a printout of the vehicle mockup on 11" x 17" paper as a guide for placement during installation.

We recommend using a layout program such as QuarkXPress or InDesign when designing for vehicle wraps. This will expedite the preflight process and ensure your job remains on schedule.




When preparing your wall for a wall mural application, the surface can be painted with any type of paint **except water-based latex paint**. Also, it is imperative that the surface has at least 24 hours to dry prior to mural application.

If these specifications are not followed your project will be delayed and/or additional charges will apply.

ARROW VISUAL DESIGN DISTILLER SETTINGS:

You may download Arrow Visual Design's PDF Job Options from http://www.arrowvisualdesign.com/art_specs/. After unzipping the file, you'll have a file called ArrowVisualDesign.joboptions. From Distiller, go to your Job Options preferences and load this preference file into Acrobat Distiller to create acceptable PDF files for high quality output.
